* On Saturday 19 July, Writing Brecht is joining forces with *Modern Poetry in Translation* and Poetry International for a reading of the love poems of **Brecht and Margarete Steffin**, in new translations by **David Constantine**. The staged reading of the poems, many available for the first time in English translation, will be directed by Di Trevis and set

to music by Dominic Muldowney. Tom Kuhn and David Constantine will tell the story of Brecht and Steffin's life together, their flight into exile, and their love.

Brecht & Steffin: Love in a Time of Exile and War is part of the Poetry International Festival at the Southbank Centre, and takes place at 2.30pm on 19 July in the Purcell Rooms.
